On Dec 9, 2022 around 1:30pm we triggered a large, <u>deep slab avalanche</u> while riding across a lower angle slope below. This occurred on Fisher Mtn. near Cooke City on an east-northeast <u>aspect</u> at 10,000'. It broke 3-6+' deep and 300' wide. One rider was caught and carried, not buried, and luckily nobody was injured.
